HOW TO FEED

This feed was developed to provide balanced nutrition for Whitetail deer, Mule deer and exotic species in confinement.

- I. Feed free-choice to deer. Consumption will vary according to age, sex, climate, and physiological state but should be in the range of two to four pounds per IOO pounds of body weight.
- 2. It is necessary to feed hay with this product. Allow 0.25 to 0.5 lb of legume hay per IOO lb of body weight daily.
- 3. Antler Advantage[™] Breeder Textured 16-5 can be fed free-choice as a creep feed to fawns. Target consumption should be about one pound per 100 pounds of body weight until weaning.
- 4. Antler Advantage[™] Breeder Textured 16-5 can be used as a weaning ration for fawns. Feed free-choice along with good quality hay after weaning. Once fawns are eating pellets, feed hay as described above for adults.

IMPORTANT CONSIDERATIONS

- A feeding program is only as effective as the management practices. Actual results can vary depending upon feed intake, environmental conditions and the quality of the management practices.
- 2. Provide a source of fresh, clean water at all times.
- 3. Provide salt free-choice.
- 4. When changing rations, the change should be made by gradually increasing the amount of new feed and decreasing the amount of old feed over a period of at least 7 days.
- 5. This is a complete feed containing adequate levels of vitamins and minerals. However, since consumption may vary among animals supplying additional Purina® AntlerMax® Deer Mineral is a good practice.
- 6. Consult your veterinarian for recommended herd health and parasite control programs.
